

#### Purpose of Government


- Punish evil and reward those who do good.
- "Let everyone be subject to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established. The authorities that exist have been established by God. Consequently, whoever rebels against the authority is rebelling against what God has instituted, and those who do so will bring judgment on themselves. For rulers hold no terror for those who do right, but for those who do wrong. Do you want to be free from fear of the one in authority? Then do what is right and you will be commended. For the one in authority is God's servant for your good. But if you do wrong, be afraid, for rulers do not bear the sword for no reason. They are God's servants, agents of wrath to bring punishment on the wrongdoer. Therefore, it is necessary to submit to the authorities, not only because of possible punishment but also as a matter of conscience." Romans 13:1-5.

- Sanctity of Life
  - Reducing abortion, euthanasia; promoting adoption; etc.
- Marriage
  - Divorce reform, policies promoting lifelong marriage; constitutional amendment defining marriage as "one man/one woman."
- Religious Liberty
- Education
  - Parental choice, vouchers, STOs, Common Core
- Gambling
- Pay Day Loans
- Many other public policy issues that impact families.
  - Stay-at-home tax credits, welfare reform, immigration, spending


#### To Shine Light In The Darkness

  - Encourage your pastor to lobby.




#### Serve


